Little Athletics SA Officials Academy – **Frequently Asked Questions**

What is the Officials Academy?

The Official's Academy is designed to give ex athletes and parents an opportunity to stay involved with the sport of athletics and the chance to become an Olympic Official.

What is Involved in the Officials Academy?

It is an exciting opportunity to learn the correct way to officiate by completing courses and putting knowledge into practice at State Events.

How old do I have to be to join the Academy?

The minimum age to be an official is 14 years old.

Is there a Selection Criteria?

You are required to have a Working With Children Check (WWCC) or be willing to obtain one.

Do I need to have any officiating experience to join?

No, you don't need any experience. The Official's Academy will provide you with the training and practice you will need to become a State Official.

What does the onboarding processes look like once I join the academy?

After registering your interest for the Officials Academy, you will be given a link to start your Level 0 courses. These are purely online and can be done at any time. Once you have completed this, you will be notified of the next steps.















When and where will the courses/sessions be held?

Once completing your expression of interest, you will be directed to complete the Level 0 Officiating Courses. A member of the SALAA team will be in contact with you for in person sessions.

What would a typical session look like?

Each session is different. It will range from theory, practical and shadowing a State Official at one of our State Events.

Can I focus on my favourite events in the Academy?

Yes, you can choose to learn how to officiate any event of your choice. However, to complete the Level 0 Courses you will be required to complete training for all events which are relevant to Little Athletics.

What do I get for joining the Academy?

You will be provided with an Officials Academy Shirt, login details for the training courses, and added to our email list for future opportunities and experiences.

What benefits do I get for joining the Academy?

By being part of the Officials Academy, you will gain new skills, work closely with SA's best event officials, be involved at state events at the stadium and become a member of the SALAA Officials Hub - Facebook Group.

Will I get to put my skills into practice?

Yes, all the skills you learn throughout the Academy will be put into practice at our State Events.
