

Drugs, Medicines, Anti-Doping and Smoke-Free Sporting Venues

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Little Athletics SA has adopted the relevant Australian Athletics policies relating to drugs, medicines, supplements, anti-doping and conduct.

These policies provide the national framework for managing matters involving the improper use, possession or supply of drugs, medicines or supplements, anti-doping obligations, and related behaviour or conduct issues.

Little Athletics SA also recognises South Australian smoke-free and vape-free sporting venue requirements. In South Australia, smoking and vaping are banned in public areas at, or within 10 metres of, a sporting venue when an organised underage sporting event, training session or practice session is taking place.
